



Norden to Scotland Heath

An easy level walk around the heathland at Norden and Scotland heath.

Distance: 2 miles
Ascent: 24m (approx)
Start Point: Purbeck Park, Norden, Corfe Castle, BH20 5DW
Coordinates: Latitude: 50.64567° N, Longitude: -2.06186° W **(OS)** SY 95723 82889

Safety Tips: Stay on marked paths, especially near cliff edges. Wear suitable footwear – paths can be uneven and slippery. Keep children and dogs under close supervision near the cliffs. Check the weather forecast before your walk. Mobile phone coverage can be patchy along the coast

Directions

1. Start in Purbeck Park Car Park

Lat, long: 50.64567, -2.06186 - OS: SY 95723 82889

Start from the Purbeck Park car park and follow track East across the car park until you come to a gate.

2. Wooden Gate

Lat, long: 50.64603, -2.05885 - OS: SY 95936 82929

Go through gate and turn left at signpost for Scotland, follow narrow path to the road.

3. Road

Lat, long: 50.64646, -2.05839 - OS: SY 95968 82976

Go across stile at the road and up steps on far side, over next stile and across open field past trees in the middle to the wood on the North side.

4. Woodland

Lat, long: 50.64794, -2.05871 - OS: SY 95945 83141

Follow footpath through the woods until you come to an open field.

5. Field

Lat, long: 50.64936, -2.05927 - OS: SY 95906 83299

Go across the field in a North-East direction to stile on far side.

6. Stile

Lat, long: 50.65234, -2.05714 - OS: SY 96057 83630

Go over stile and follow track through heathland and trees heading North until you come to a tarmac road.

7. Road

Lat, long: 50.65598, -2.05674 - OS: SY 96085 84035

Turn left at the road and continue along the road until you come to a T junction after stone railway bridge.

8. T Junction

Lat, long: 50.64557, -2.06520 - OS: SY 95486 82878

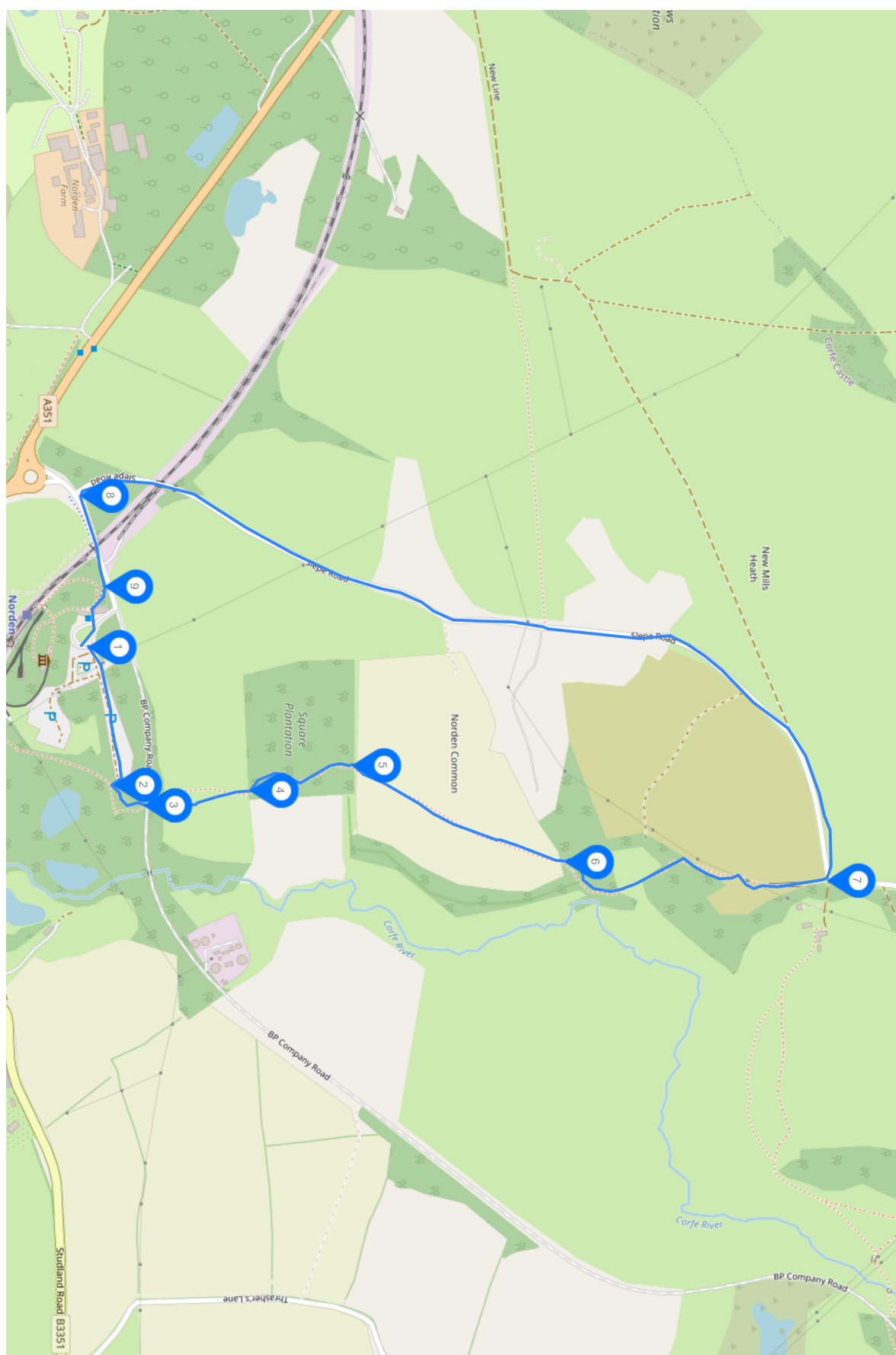
Turn left at the T junction and follow road back to the entrance to Purbeck Park.

9. Purbeck Park Entrance

Lat, long: 50.64591, -2.06321 - OS: SY 95627 82916

Go across the road at the entrance to Purbeck Park and return to the start of your walk.
